Re: Construction Season and COVID 19.

Traditionally, April 1 is the date when construction can begin on new coach houses within the resort. To date, there are no federal or state restrictions placed upon the construction industry other than requiring that the worksite is maintained as a healthy work environment; provides sanitation supplies, maintains social distancing, and screens and dismisses workers for signs of illness.

The most recent guidelines from the Department of Homeland Security, as well as orders from various counties in Florida (not including Hendry) that have placed restrictions upon their residents, include contractors and other tradesmen in the list of businesses performing essential services.

Because there are a limited number of contractors who do this work and the work is essentially conducted in an outdoor environment, the resort will follow this same timeline with the expectation that these contractors follow the guidelines we have established in order for them to gain access to the park.

The contractor must ensure that all workers are healthy and screen them daily. The crew must answer **NO** to all the following questions in order to provide services on site:

- Is anyone in your household presently unhealthy?
- Is anyone in your household presently self-quarantined?
- Has anyone in your household been medically directed to be quarantined?

Anyone with signs of illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath) must be dismissed from the crew that will work within RiverBend. If necessary, the contractor must issue hand sanitizer to all members of the crew or ensure that it is readily available.

It is essential that those owners interacting with members of a construction crew maintain at least six feet between individuals.
